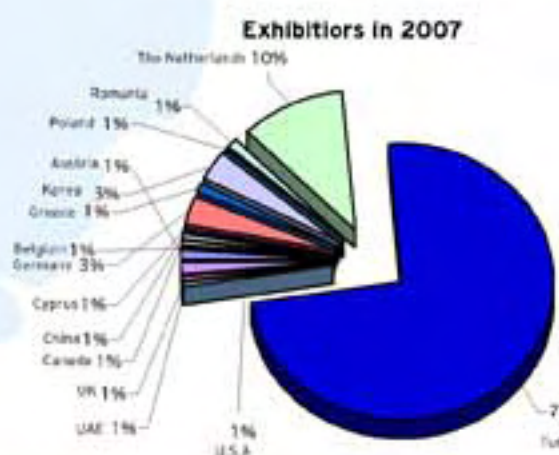
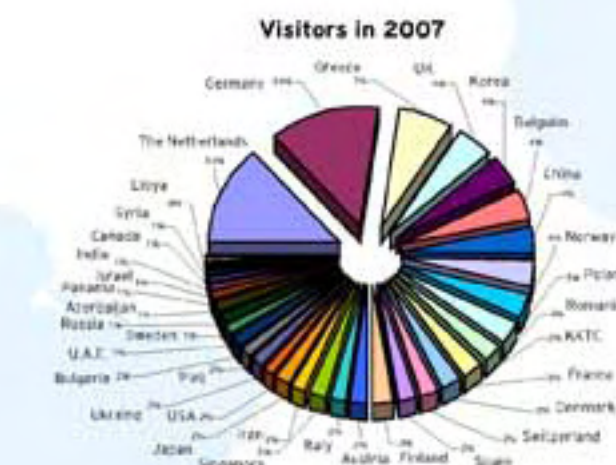

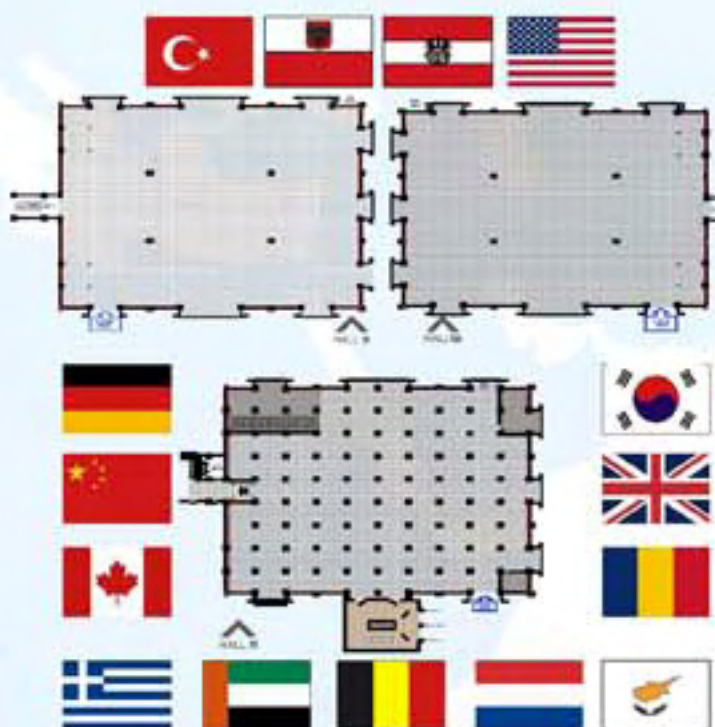
## Lets meet in the "heart" of Europe and Asia...

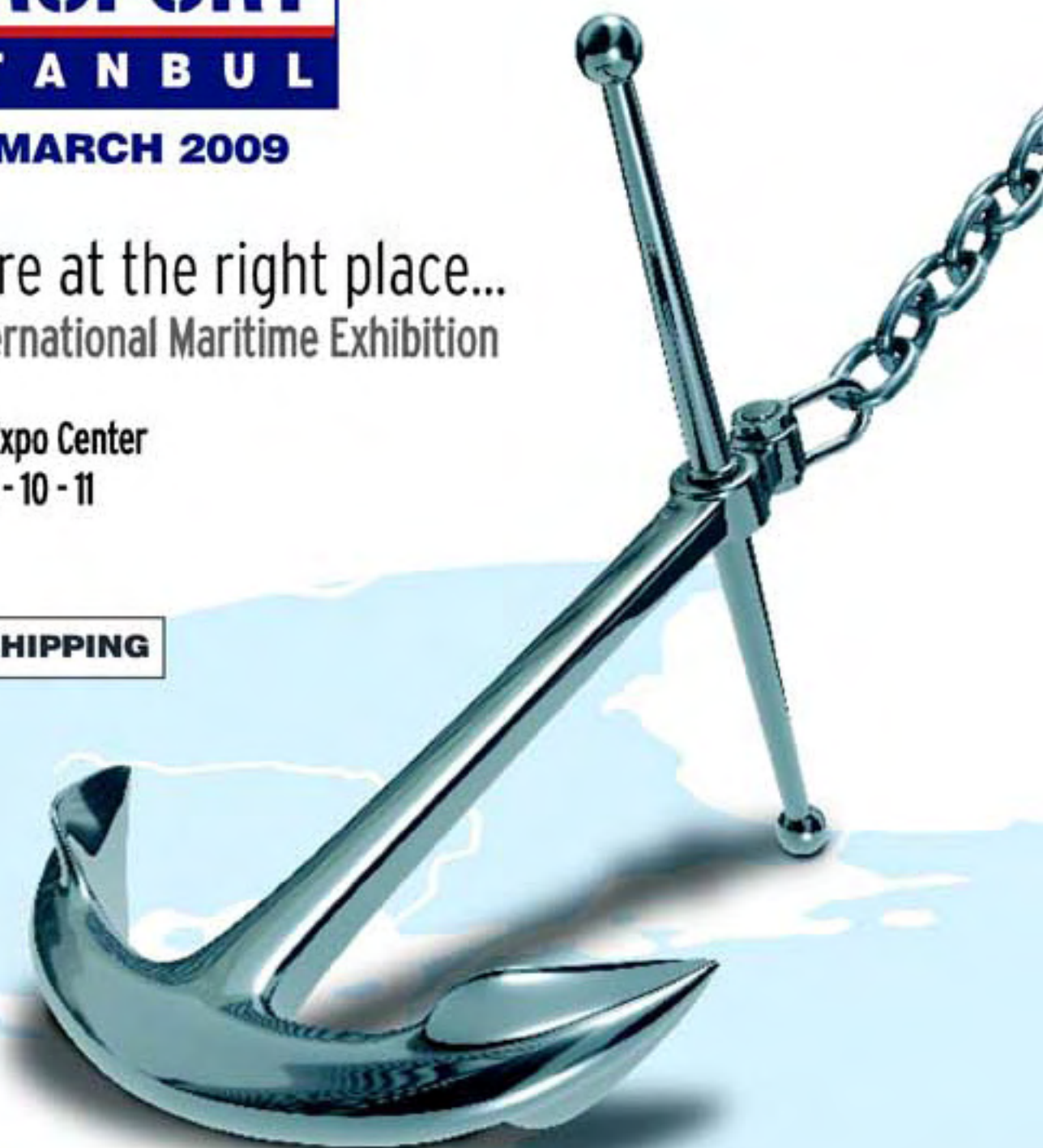
