





Jiangsu accounts for China offshore market

The need of China offshore engineering industry will reach more than 45 billion US dollars in next ten years, which will even reach more than 100 billion US dollars in South Sea oil & gas exploring.






Discovery of oil fields in China in 2010

Offshore wind energy corridor---Jiangsu new business card

Offshore wind energy corridor will become a new mainstay of Jiangsu coastal industry, and Jiangsu is becoming Chinese biggest offshore wind energy industrial base.



Your gateway to the No. 1 offshore industry hub in China

- Jiangsu is the No.1 offshore industrial base in China, accounting for 45% of the total Chinese offshore industry! It is located along the coast of the West Pacific and the East China Sea with abundant offshore resources. and advanced technology in offshore platform, shipbuilding, oil & gas drilling, wind energy, underwater engineering and port construction!
- From 2011 to 2015, the annual global offshore market will reach 81 billion US dollars on average. The Chinese share will increase from 5%-7% presently to 20% in 2015, and reach 19 billion US dollars, 5 times higher than that in 2010.
- Jiangsu offshore industry benefits a lot from the shipbuilding! In 2010, its accomplished output (Accounting for 35.1% in China; 15.3% in the world), newly received orders (39.5% in China; 21.6% in the world) and handholding orders (37.8% in China, 15.6% in the world) account for more than 35% of China, most biggest Jiangsu shipyards are involved in offshore!
- · Ch Rongsheng, COSCO Nantong Shipyard, the first Chinese Ocean Equipment Alliance, the first and the only Chinese Offshore Industry Association are all located in Jiangsu.

Abundant B2B events - to enhance a trade platform

- · Free match-making with Chinese offshore industry, which also attracts many ship designers, shipbrokers to participate.
- · Trade mission to Jiangsu offshore shipyards.

The organizer will help to arrange trade missions for foreign exhibitors after OTE 2012.

 Abundant conferences focus on: offshore Tec, offshore wind energy, oil drilling, delivery and storage, etc.

Biggest Chinese market and foreign investment absorber

- The Yangtze River Delta area is the most important economy engine in China, with the best investment absorbing environment for foreign offore-tec to set up joint-venture in China, and strongest purchasing ability. 95% of offshore equipments are imported from abroad!
- The total ship equipment import volume in Jiangsu reached 217 million US Dollars in 2010, accounts for 1/4 of China, largely surpassed other areas.
- · Jiangsu has 954 KM coast line along the Yellow sea, acrossed by the Yangtze River; Jiangsu Coastal Campaign has become China National Strategy, which will largely push the development of its offshore industry with more business opportunity.


