Active maritime industry

Over the last 10 years, the Romanian maritime industry has undergone strong development and modernisation.

There are now 12 large shipyards in operation involved in the ship repair industry and in the construction of inland navigation ships, multipurpose ships, tankers, Ro-Ro's, freighters, tugboats, patrol boats, LPG carriers, supply vessels and dredgers to keep the Danube navigational. Some of these shipyards are also involved in the highly lucrative ocean yacht market sector.



The opportunity to meet Romanian defence specialists

The Romanian Navy is looking into the possibilities of modernising its fleet - hence the presence of two Royal Netherlands Navy vessels. In some instances, this will entail the construction of new vessels but in other cases, service life extension programmes will be put in place. Naval & Maritime Exhibition Romania offers a one-time opportunity to meet delegations from the Romanian Defence Department.

Constanta is known as the place where Ahoy organises its biannual Europort Romania. In 2010, this successful trade fair will be held for the sixth time. Fleet visit of HMS Rotterdam and HMS Johan de Witt of the Royal Netherlands Navy *

During the exhibition, these two giant amphibian cargo vessels (LPDs) of the Dutch Navy will be docked at the Constanta Shipyard. Later they will take part in multilateral exercises with the Romanian Navy.

Meeting on board

Meetings will take place on board HMS Rotterdam and HMS Johan de Witt between the Romanian shipyards' management and specialists from the Romanian Navy in the area of shipbuilding, maintenance and equipment. A full tour will be provided. Participants will have an opportunity to implement their knowledge gained from the information and presentations given by the exhibitors. There is a shuttle service from the exhibition hall to and from the moorings of both Navy vessels.


